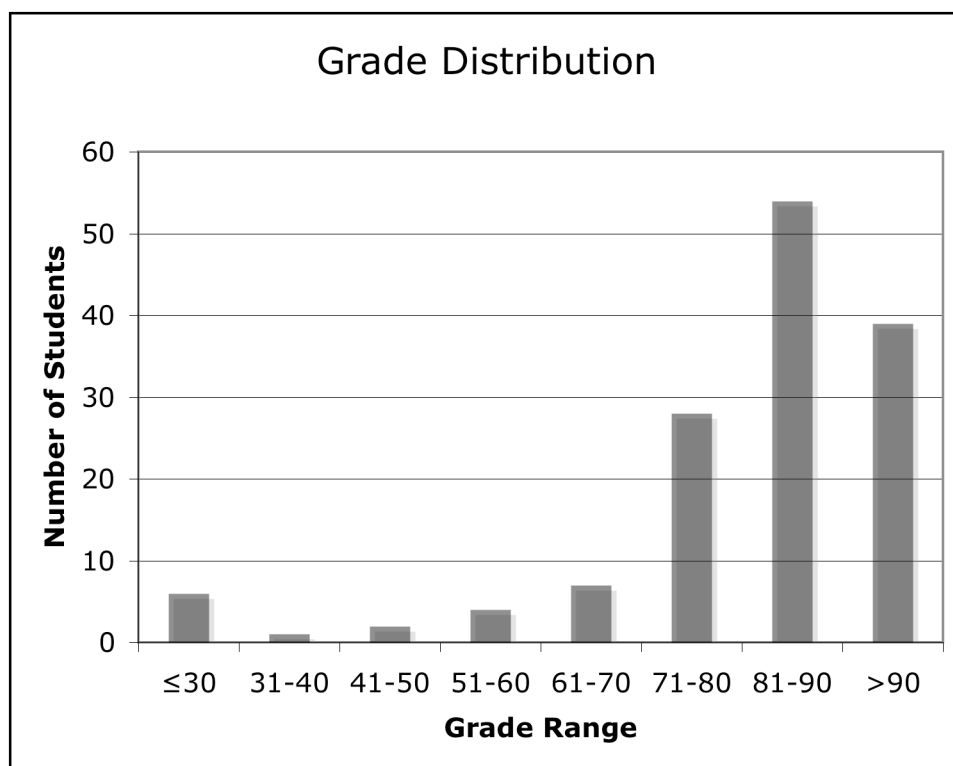

Exam and Quiz Regrade Policy

Exams and quizzes are graded by experienced graduate students. If you feel that a question on the Exam or a Quiz has not been graded properly, then simply *write the number of the question on the Exam or Quiz and hand it back to me*. I will review the grade under the following terms:

- Changes must be for more than 1 pt (except addition errors)
- If you ask for a regrade, then you will receive my grade for whole question (on an Exam) or Quiz, not just the part that you ask for regrading. I may assign partial credit differently from the TA, so your score could go up, stay the same, or occasionally even go down. Be sure that you are comfortable with the whole answer and its grade before handing a question or Quiz back for regrade.
- The Exam or Quiz that you submit for regrade should not contain *any* writing that was not on the original submission.

Quiz/Exam Scanning

We keep scanned copies of quizzes and exams and will compare your submission for regrade with the original. We taking cheating on regrade submissions very seriously.

Statue of Limitations
